We are honored and delighted that you and your clan or society are coming to Clanjamfry. The festival is to be held **September 24-26, 2010**. The festival begins the evening of Friday, September 24, but the grounds of Evergreen Presbyterian Church will of course be available that entire day for arrival and set-up. - Scottish Faire, Evergreen Presbyterian Church lawn, 10:00 AM-5:00 PM
- Plaid Pooch Promenade (our new Doggie Parade!), 10:00 AM
- Evening Concert with **Laura McGhee**, Evergreen Presbyterian Church sanctuary, 7 PM

Sunday, September 26

- Kirkin' of the Tartans, Evergreen Presbyterian Church sanctuary, 11:00 AM
- Dinner on the Grounds, Evergreen Presbyterian Church lawn, Noon

To help you with your plans, here is additional, important information...

- Clan Representatives are guests of Clanjamfry at the Sponsor and Clan Reception and ceilidh Friday night as well as the Faire on Saturday. And of course, you are guests at Kirkin and the Dinner on the Grounds Sunday as well.
- The Faire gates open at 10:00 AM Saturday; you must be ready to receive visitors at that time. Please arrive early to make the necessary preparations.
- Please make sure your tent or enclosure is no more than 10 feet on a side. You must provide any table coverings that you may require.
- Clanjamfry cannot provide electricity to a clan tent.
- **All vehicles must be off the grounds Saturday by 9:00 AM** and will not be allowed back on the grounds until the close of the Faire. There will be a designated parking area at the church for clans. A parking pass, which you must display in your front windshield, will be sent to you upon receipt of your confirmation.
- Opening ceremonies for the Faire commence at noon Saturday (subject to scheduling fluctuations) and include the introduction of the Honored Clan, announcement of visiting dignitaries, and the Parade of Tartans.
- If your clan's chief or society's president will be attending Clanjamfry, please let me know by **August 30** so his or her name can go in the program to be printed.
- Security will be present on-site Friday evening and continuing through Sunday morning. However, please be aware that you leave your setup and equipment at your own risk. Evergreen Presbyterian Church is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen goods.
- Clanjamfry is an outdoor event, so please bring your own provisions in the event of inclement weather. **Clanjamfry will take place rain or shine.**
- Please **do not** strike your tents until after closing on Saturday (5:00 PM)
- We believe that the Memphis area is a location ripe for a Scottish festival and a gathering of the clans. The crowds get bigger each year and they love to see the clans.
